



HYPERGLYCEMIC HYPEROSMOLAR STATE

Hyperglycemic Hyperosmolar State (HHS) is a serious condition that occurs when blood glucose levels become extremely high, leading to severe dehydration and altered mental status.

EARLY SYMPTOMS

- EXCESSIVE THIRST
- FREQUENT URINATION
- DRY MOUTH
- WEAKNESS OR FATIGUE



ADVANCED SYMPTOMS

- CONFUSION OR DROWSINESS
- RAPID BREATHING
- SEIZURES OR COMA
- HIGH BLOOD GLUCOSE LEVELS (OFTEN VERY HIGH)



CAUSES

- INFECTION OR ILLNESS
- INADEQUATE INSULIN OR DIABETES MEDICATION
- POOR DIABETES MANAGEMENT
- DEHYDRATION
