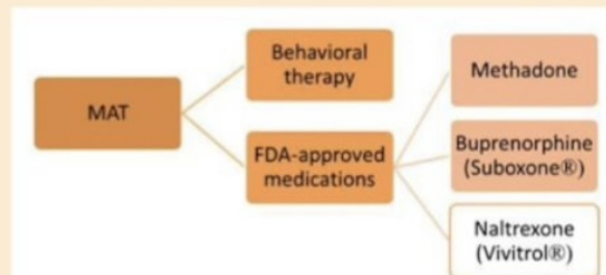
Opioid Overdose- Among the 2022 overdose deaths, nearly **76%** involved an opioid



Signs of Opioid Addiction

- Trying to stop or cut down on drug use, but not being able to.
- Taking one drug to get over the effects of another.
- Stealing drugs or money to pay for drugs.
- Being arrested or hospitalised for drug use.
- Overdosing on drugs.

Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder



What To Do?

- Reach out, if you think you or someone you know has a problem.
- Talk to family members, friends, or a health care professional.
- Be supportive (not judgmental) if a loved one has a problem.
- Show support towards people in recovery.
